What is Saab Trackday 2006?

It's a Trackday purely for Saab owners, a chance to explore the potential of your car safely away from the public roads and meet with friendly, likeminded people! We are building on the success of our two very successful exclusively Saab Trackdays at Anglesey in 2003/4 and at Goodwood in 2005. In 2003, Some 17 Saabs, including 99turbos, classic 900s, 9000s, 9-3s and a 9-5, and a greater number of drivers joined us at the Anglesey race circuit. Even more Saabs and spectators attended despite the rather wet conditions on the day. In 2004 we returned to Anglesey on July 9th, we were presented with glorious welsh sunshine, and an oversubscription of a wide range of Saabs, from 100bhp to 450bhp, see www.saabtrackday.co.uk for a report and photos of our previous events.
